
This time of transition also has an impact on our Fall programs. Here is a quick overview with a basic idea of volunteer opportunities.



Meghan and Brad served as key leaders for our middle school ministry this past year and did an amazing job, connecting, teaching and building relationships with our students. When the opportunity came up to fill the Youth Ministry Intern position, Meghan was the natural choice! On July 12th she officially began her time with LCC as the Youth Ministry Intern and soon to be seminary student at North Park Seminary. It has been abundantly evident that God has a call on her life and is inviting her to consider a pastoral call. Unknown to all of us was the fact that God was inviting my family to step away from Libertyville Covenant. This created a unique situation for Meghan and for the church. In recent weeks Meghan, the executive committee and myself have been meeting to re-frame some of Meghan's role moving forward to address the transition of leadership. Meghan will still pursue her seminary degree while serving as a key facilitator for youth ministry during this interim period. Meghan is actively recruiting leaders, putting a manageable plan in place and connecting with students and parents to build momentum and confidence for the fall. Meghan will operate as a point person for youth ministry at LCC while depending heavily on volunteer support during this transitional time. 
