“Reaching Out”



Someone was once asked to describe a football game in as few words as possible. Their response was priceless: *“Football is 22 people who desperately need rest cheered on by 22,000 people who desperately need exercise.”*

As we enter a New Year in 2017, we are going to be focusing our teaching, our work, and our time together on Reaching Out. We spend a lot of our “spiritual growth time” on our own growth or that of our family, but the mission of our church reaches out beyond that. We are called by God and equipped by the Holy Spirit to grow disciples, grow the church, and grow the Kingdom of God. This means that of our 3 areas of ministry, 2 of them force us to reach out beyond ourselves.

So as we begin the year, we have to ask ourselves whether we're one of the 22 or one of the 22,000. Are we truly spending ourselves on ministry and the work of God or are we cheering on those who are? It is

the expectation of our church that every one of us be involved in the work of the church – in fact, we all promised to do that when we became members - and in general we do pretty well. There is an old saw called the “80/20 rule” which states that in most churches, 80% of the work is



done by 20% of the people. For us, that would mean about 45 people. But in my experience, we have far more than that involved in ministry at LCC. Between our Council and Committees, our worship leaders and Sunday school teachers, our staff and volun-

teen leadership, we have a pretty healthy percentage of our people ministering at our church. But most of our ministry is still focused on ourselves, our own growth, rather than on Reaching Out.

We can do better. This year as we work toward a number of new initiatives, including experiencing a Mission Trip, providing housing to low-income families, and intentionally welcoming those outside the church into the life of LCC, I want to challenge you to take another step of growth when it comes to ministry. If you aren't involved in a ministry here at LCC, I'd like to encourage you to join one. We provide opportunities to move furniture and to teach the bible, to provide meals to those sick or tired and to sit and listen as someone shares their burdens. Through LCC you can mentor a child and you can host a dinner.

But most importantly, you can take the challenge to help us welcome new people into our church. Will you commit to invite someone every month to join you for worship or Wednesday night? Will you host a dinner at your home for your neighbors so you can build relationship with them? Every one of us can Reach Out from our church doors. Let's join the 22 and see if we can't grow our church for God.

This January, our sermon series is going to have us reflecting on our place in the Kingdom of God. Based on Isaiah 11, we'll be looking at our part in God's Family Tree, at the history that brought us to this point and continues to nourish us, and at the fruit that God is bearing in us and our church.
