The Discipleship Challenge

t was June and the Year of Discipleship had just begun. As our Leadership Team sat in Jill's living room, we explored just what discipleship looked like. We had earlier decided to present a unifying theme for the year, and that theme was the first of our three Mission Statement goals: to Grow Disciples. And so we talked about the need for both information (disciple means "learner") and transformation (a disciple is one who becomes like their leader). We talked about the need for

grow as disciples. We begin with our fall sermon series looking at Jesus' disciples as shared in the book of Matthew. But we will see this theme again and again throughout the year in everything we do.



As we kick off this Year of Discipleship, we have a challenge before us. It's called the Discipleship Challenge and it is three-fold. First, we are challenged to come to church every week we can. We all have weeks we just can't come due to illness, travel, or work. But worship is our primary activity as a church, and it is there that we come together as a congregation to grow. So part one of our three-fold Discipleship chalContinued from page 1

lenge is to come to church every Sunday we can.

Part two is to take part in an activity that intentionally fills us as disciples. This could be a bible study or small group, a youth group or kids club, Sunday school or Discipleship Encounter, a book study or something else we haven't done yet. This is not a time to serve, work, or lead but a time to be fed, to learn, to discuss and contemplate. If one of our current offerings don't feed you, tell us what will and we will work to make that happen this vear.

Part three is to take part in an activity that uses your Godgiven gifts to serve others. Whether serving on a leadership Team or cooking meals on Wed. night, whether singing in the choir or on a worship team or for special music, whether moving furniture or going on a mission trip, whether praying every day for someone in need or sharing Jesus with one neighbor each month, this is the chance to put your learning into practice.

So spend some time each week in our memorial garden, come to worship on Sunday. and join a small group. Serve on a leadership team, go to Sunday school and join us for worship when you'd rather just sleep in. There are thousands of combinations for those who agree to take the Discipleship Challenge this year. But whether you sign up for the challenge or not. God is calling you this year to Grow as His Disciple. How that happens is up to Him.






