he Discipleship Journey is a path we all walk though we are at different places along the way. There is no right or wrong place on that path. And there is no right or wrong pace at which any of us walk it. The only time we need correction on the path is when we guit walking.

As we enter a new year and the second half of our Year of Discipleship, consider the next step of your Discipleship journey. How might you grow as a disciple of Jesus Christ this year? Perhaps it is a commitment or recommitment to our Discipleship Challenge: to attend worship every week you can, take part in a ministry that helps you grow, and take part in a ministry that helps you serve. But perhaps rather than doing something new, your next step is to actu-




- 1. Please continue sending us the Companion free of charge.
