



Women growing older contend with ageism, misogyny, and loss. Yet as Mary Pipher shows, most older women are deeply happy and filled with gratitude for the gifts of life. Their struggles help them grow into the authentic, empathetic, and wise people they have

always wanted to be.

In *Women Rowing North*, Pipher offers a timely examination of the cultural and developmental issues women face as they age. Drawing on her own experience as daughter, sister, mother, grandmother, caregiver, clinical psychologist, and cultural anthropologist, she explores ways women can cultivate resilient responses to the challenges they face. "If we can keep our wits about us, think clearly, and manage our emotions skillfully," Pipher writes, "we will experience a joyous time of our lives. If we have planned carefully and packed properly, if we have good maps and guides, the journey can be transcendent."

#### **Unite North Recap**

What an incredible time we had at UNITE North!!! Our group of 14 students and leaders joined together with 755 high school students, leaders, and volunteers representing 57 churches. Church from Alberta, British Colombia, Iowa, Illinois, Manitoba, Michigan, Minnesota, Ontario, North Dakota, Saskatchewan, South Dakota, and Wisconsin came together for this meaningful time together. Saturday evening during our time of worship it was estimated that over 200 students stood to their feet to commit to following Christ. Sunday morning 98% of the audience stood to commit to pursuing Jesus by being accountable, studying the Bible daily, and saying, "I want Jesus to run my life."

Events like Unite provide amazing experiences for our students and leaders. Author Madeline L'Engle once said, "The party's not over until the stories are told." As family, both at home and at church, we have an opportunity and responsibility to get and keep our kids talking about these amazing experiences. Church, I would like to invite you to talk to our students about the fun things they did, about the experiences they had, about the things that have challenged them, about the emotions they felt, and the things they have learned.

It's vital for us to see these stories as important for the life and growth of the whole church as well, not only for individual students or the youth group.
