## This is Good News

Peter and the disciples had been through a lot with Jesus. Leaving everything to follow this Rabbi, becoming his Disciples, and then watching Him die, tortured to death by the very Romans He as Messiah was supposed to overthrow. But then came the Resurrection, and their worlds took on a whole new level of crazy. Jesus reminded them that His death paid the price for all of their sins, and for



everyone else's. No more need for the sacrifices they had lived with their whole lives. No more need for temple, for Jesus was their temple now, the place where they met God, filled with His glory. Everything in their faith life had changed with His death, and then the rest changed with His resurrection. Now it wasn't just the sacrificial system and the temple that was obsolete – now DEATH ITSELF was obsolete. They would live forever with Jesus, after they died here on earth that is.

"So THAT happened."

But now what? Jesus had stayed with them for a while, finishing up His teaching, reminding them — with this new perspective everything made a different kind of sense now — of all He had taught before. And then He left. He returned to heaven with a promise that He'd be back "soon". So now what? Jesus had always been there to guide them before. He had always told them where to go and what to do. But now they were alone, left with nothing but memories and a mission — to make disciples of Jesus. And just how were they supposed to do that?!?

Jesus had an answer for them. And that answer was the Holy Spirit. Through God's Holy Spirit, given to the disciples on Pentecost and to all believers, some at their baptism, some before, but given to all of them, God would still guide them, empower them, and send them out in mission. And so they went, and the world was never the same.

And do you know what? You have been given the same gift as Peter, as John, as James, as Mary, as Cornelius, as all of those Christians who went before you. Jesus died to pay the price for YOUR sins, so you are free! Jesus rose again and YOU are in the midst of an eternal life with Jesus. YOU have been given the Holy Spirit, in your own unique way, but still the same Spirit. YOU have God's guidance through this Spirit. YOU are

empowered for ministry. And YOU have been sent out into this world by God to make disciples. This is more than Good News! This is God's love poured out for YOU.

"So THAT happened." For YOU. So now what?



All Church Clean Up: April 27th from 9 am to noon!! Lots to do inside and out! Many hands make for light work.



### **PADS PROJECT**


